## Our Service

- We are a pre-planned, non-emergency transport service for patients going to, and returning from, medical appointments.
- You will be escorted from your lounge room or home entrance to, and from, the clinic waiting room.
- We provide friendly reminders to ensure Medicare cards, mobile phones, referral letters, house keys and other essentials are taken to, and from, appointments.
- We also assist with locking/unlocking the front door at home if required.



## Appointment Changes

- We understand appointments may run late and we will work with the Clinic to adjust pick-up times.
- If your appointment is cancelled with 3 hours' notice, no charges will be incurred.



## Our People & Vehicles

- Our personnel are trained in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and able to administer First Aid.
- They hold, as a minimum, a Certificate III in Non-Emergency Patient Transport.
- Our fleet comprises stretcher ambulances and sedans. All vehicles carry a defibrillator.
- Our clinic cars have wheelchairs to assist ambulant patients if there is a long distance to walk from the clinic car park to the appointment waiting room.



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
